Prerequisites: German 1110 & 1210 or permission of the instructor.

Participants: A maximum of 16 students will be accepted. Early submission of applications is recommended.

Program Fee: \$1950 (all students eligible for \$500 CUEF funding)

Fees Include: This price includes tuition paid to TRU, accommodation, and meals. Students are responsible for additional costs including airfare, passport fees, travel medical insurance, personal spending money, etc.

Deposit: A \$500.00 deposit must be submitted with application in the form of a cheque made out to Thompson Rivers University. The deposit (cheque) will be cashed once accepted into the course.
