Notes to the FTE Enrolment Report Year ended March 31, 2009

#### 1. Basis of FTE Calculation:

A revised FTE Audited Enrolment Reporting Manual was issued in September 2005 by the British Columbia Ministry of Advanced Education and Labour Market Development ("the Ministry"). Following Ministry directives, this manual was used to calculate student FTE Enrolment in this report. In accordance with Ministry communications, course extensions are counted for FTE reporting purposes where a fee has been charged for the extension.

In the current year certain minimum divisors used in calculating FTEs for Open Learning courses were changed, in accordance with the FTE Audited Enrolment Reporting Manual, to more accurately reflect the program calendar. Accordingly, comparative FTE figures have been adjusted to be calculated on the same basis. The impact on comparative figures is an increase in total ALMD non-targeted FTEs of 329. In addition, total international FTE comparative figures decreased by 306 compared to those previously reported, to remove offshore international FTEs no longer being reported, to be consistent with current year reporting. These two changes impact total comparative FTEs by a net increase of 23.

## 2. Industrial Training Authority Enrolments:

This report includes enrolments for Entry Level Trades and Apprenticeship training funded by the Ministry for which enrolment targets have not been provided.

### 3. International Enrolments:

This report includes enrolments for International Students. These enrolments, calculated based on course credits or class hours, are shown separately as they are not counted towards the target established by the Ministry.
