Award for Excellence in Interculturalization

This award is designed to increase intercultural understanding at TRU, as well as recognize individuals and/or teams who through their practice and service are assisting to enhance intercultural understanding and engagement, namely:

- **Increase the number of intercultural opportunities for TRU community members and the broader communities we serve.**
- **Increase opportunities for TRU employees to engage in initiatives, research, teaching, and/or service with an intercultural focus.**
- **Develop partnerships with communities or institutions for joint research, scholarship, engagement and exchange opportunities.**
- **Develop, design, and revise initiatives, projects, programs and/or curricula to incorporate intercultural perspectives and increase awareness of issues related to Indigenization or inclusive internationalization.**
- **Expand TRU's intercultural activities with local and global communities.**
- **Enhance support and services available to culturally diverse students.**
- **Provide training opportunities for faculty and staff to develop cultural awareness and sensitivity.**

Full time, part-time and sessional faculty members and staff (including teams such as research partners, project teams advancing intercultural priorities) are eligible to receive the award. Teams and individual nominations will be weighted equitably.
