ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW PROGRAMS:

Pre-Health Science Certificate (open admission)

Certificate in Entrepreneurial Skills 1 (open admission)

Certificate in Entrepreneurial Skills 2 (open admission)

Certificate in First Nations Taxation Administration** C+ or better in Principles of Math 11 or Applications of Math 12, or MATH 051, or equivalent; 73% on the combined English 12 and Government exam (within the last five years), or Level 4 on the composition section of the LPI (within the last two years), or completion of ENGL 060, or completion of CESL 053, CESL 054 and CESL 057 with a grade of C+ or better. Basic computer literacy with Microsoft Office applications such as Word and Excel spreadsheets is recommended.

*** Note: it was agreed to table consideration of the Certificate in First Nations Taxation Administration to allow for further consultation. PCOL conducted an email vote after the consultation had taken place, and the program has now been approved.*

ADMN 426 (BBUS 415/455) Investments 2 (prerequisites: ADMN 318 strongly recommended)

ADMN 427 (BBUS 416) Portfolio Management (prerequisites: ADMN 318 strongly recommended)

ADMN 344 (BBUS 445) E-Commerce (prerequisite: ADMN 250)

ADMN 375 (BBUS 475) New Venture Creation (prerequisite: ADMN 250 and ADMN 336)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR EXISTING COURSES:

ADMN 380 International Business

Refinement of a prerequisite, not an addition: Recommended 30 credits, and courses such as ADMN 250, BUSM 100 and BUSM 121 are recommended.

ADMN 347 Consumer Behaviour

Prerequisite: An introductory course in marketing such as ADMN 250 is recommended.

ADMN 405 Advanced Management Accounting

Prerequisites: ADMN 333 or equivalent course in intermediate management accounting and ADMN 336 (or BUSM 236) are also strongly recommended.
