*She lives **in** Kamloops.*

*He lives **on** Summit Drive.*

*They live **at** 2555 Summit Drive, Kamloops.*

	Usage	Examples	Picture
In	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> enclosed spaces/ area 	in Canada in the House of Learning in the garden	
On	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> surfaces small islands 	on the table on the 3 rd floor on the wall	
At	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> specific place/ point an event 	at TRU at the party at the cinema	

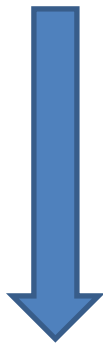
Time

*The concert is **in** the morning.*

*The game is **on** Monday.*

*The speech is **at** 10:00 am.*

	Usage	Examples	Picture
In	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> months, years and periods of time 	in the morning in 1989 in the thirties	
On	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> days of the week and calendar days 	on Monday on Monday, June 5 th	
At	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> specific time 	at 5:00 pm BUT at night, at midnight, at noon
