## Graduate Program Coordinators:

- Graduate studies are siloed- is there a high level course that all grad students take? Bring the students together. Maybe a seminar series. Collaborations between the programs for the benefit of the students.
  - o How to write or how to use the library at a graduate level
  - Executive course, supervisory skills, etc
  - Much more extensive orientation
- Graduate Mentorship student program is strong. Would be nice if could have more possibility for more mentors as programs grow
- Study space we need to plan for the future and make sure there is enough
  - Programs call space 'research space' rather than 'graduate research space' so that future planning can include both graduate and undergraduate
- Build infrastructure for graduate programs so we can work towards a Faculty of Graduate Studies
- Collaborations with industry is important and a key piece
- Workshops are great, but consistent profiling of what there is and better coordination for workshops
  - o Communication with the students
  - Send information to program coordinators and admin staff in a way that can be loaded onto moodle
- Help with stats across all of the programs and ongoing support (workshops and drop in centre)
- Create teaching assistantships to support international students with their writing. Students are not accessing support from writing centre
- Incentives for graduate supervisory and embed into promotion and tenure
- Graduate studies advisors- centralized, university-wide
- Choosing/ finding a supervisor is difficult
  - o Key word searches for faculty that might have their area of interest
